

I like Kathy Reichs a lot. Her area of expertise is fascinating and I love reading how Dr. Brennan gets the job done. While I won't rehash the who, what, when, where, and why of this particular book (that can be read elsewhere), I will say that I'm bothered by the immaturity of Dr. B when it comes to her relationship with Ryan. As a writer of romance, I have been told many times that a conflict between characters isn't real if it can be cleared up with one conversation. All Dr. B had to do was ask Ryan a couple of questions or tell him that she is insecure in their relationship. Instead, she is rude, uncommunicative, and just plain silly every time they're together. That ploy is wearing thin. She's smarter than that.

As for the plot, I thought it was excellent, clear, and intriguing. I didn't have the issues with her

running into danger unprepared that some other reviewers have. I thought Ms Reich set up Dr. B's obsession with the case pretty well, making her actions justifiable if foolish. I still find myself skimming some of the historical detail and in-depth explanations to get to the good stuff. But over all, I liked this book.
